Team Efficiency- Fighter pilot (in collaboration with Mach3 Management)



### What?

A Half day workshop to develop and train team efficiency and communication skills. Team members have to complete challenges using VR flight simulators, under supervision of Pierre-Henri Chuet ( fighter pilot from the french navy), using techniques issued from military training, and that made their proof in combat zones.



### Who?

## Benefits for participants

Participants will test their capacity to organize themselves as a team in a time-constrained and potentially stressful set of tasks. They will get feedback and train to improve their personal efficiency as well as their role as part of a team. Focus will be put on preparation, stress management, coordination and lessons learned management

## Programme highlights

This session is based on a blend of short Masertclass sessions and concrete exercises(using flight simulators and Virtual Reality). Exercises are followed by feedback sessions to participants and applicable learnings are derived from observation. Instructors and facilitators are issued from military avation and will apply technologies to coach participants.

## MAIN TRAINER



PIERRE-HENRI CHUET ("ATÉ")

After being Europe's youngest pilot at 15 in 2001 and flying in the French national Precision Flying team for the 2006 World Championships, he joined the French Navy to fly jets. After 26 months as an exchange Officer in the US NAVY he graduated as a Naval Aviator and flew Super-Etendard from the aircraft carrier Charles de Gaulle. In 2014 he transitioned to the Dassault Rafale. "Até" deployed several times including after the 2015 French terrorist attacks. He flew missions over Iraq, flying combat missions from the French aircraft carrier both at night and day. He received a Cross for Military Valor for meritorious action in the face of the enemy. After flying for several seasons in the French Navy Tactical Display as wingman he became the Leader of the display in 2017. Meanwhile, he was appointed Rafale Navy Subject Matter Expert and chief instructor for the Rafale in the navy. "Até" holds over 2500 hours of flight time including more than 1850 hours on fighter aircraft. He flew a wide range of aircraft from general aviation or aerobatics aircraft to Business jets and of course fighter aircraft. He holds over 200 carrier landings.
